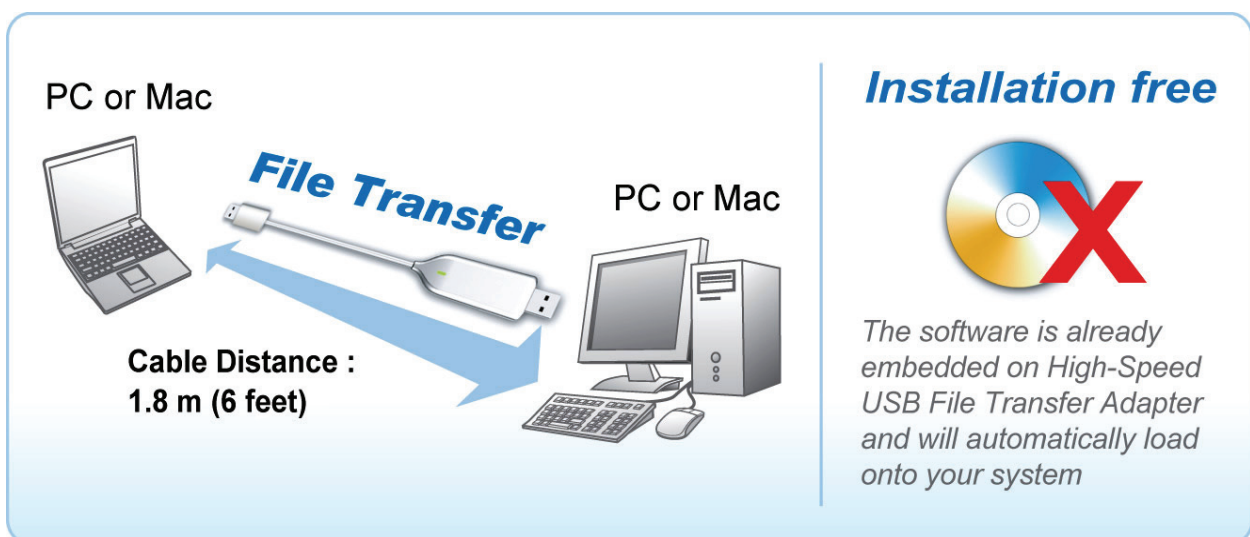

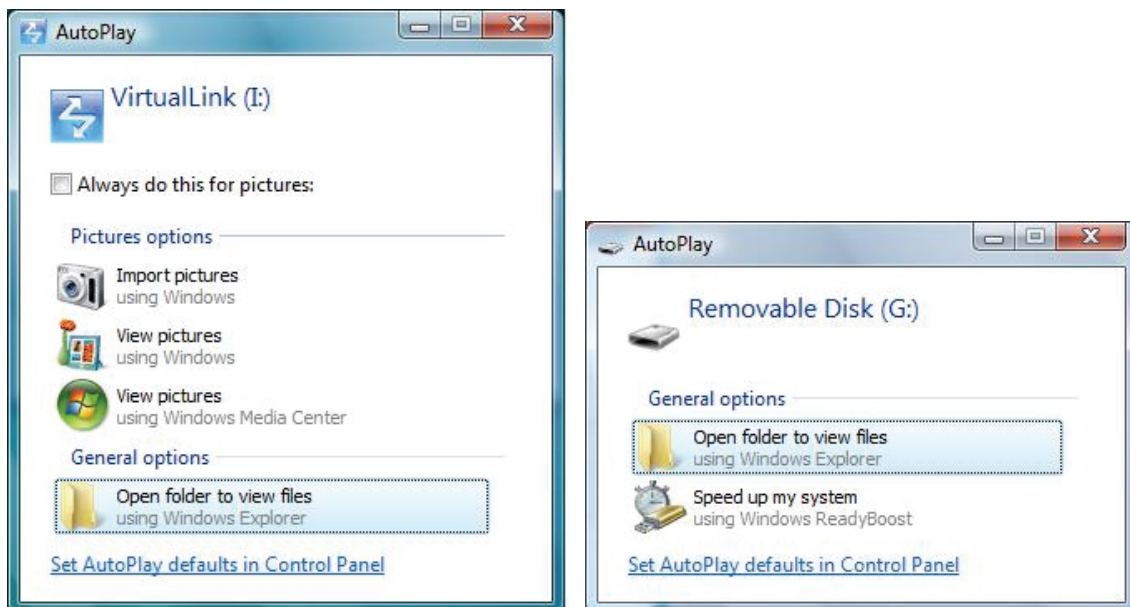

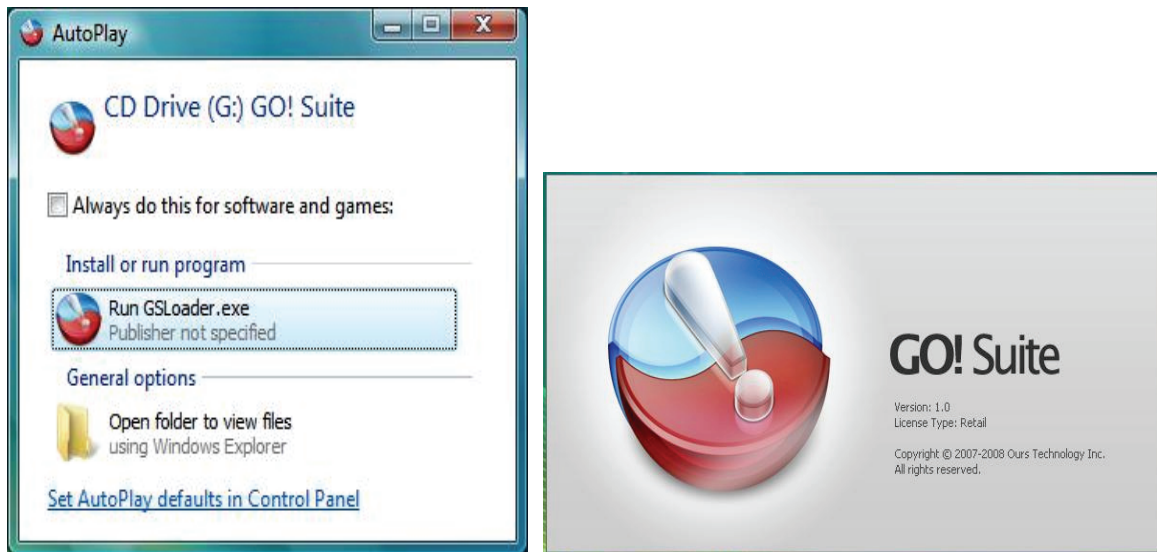
# 2. Installation

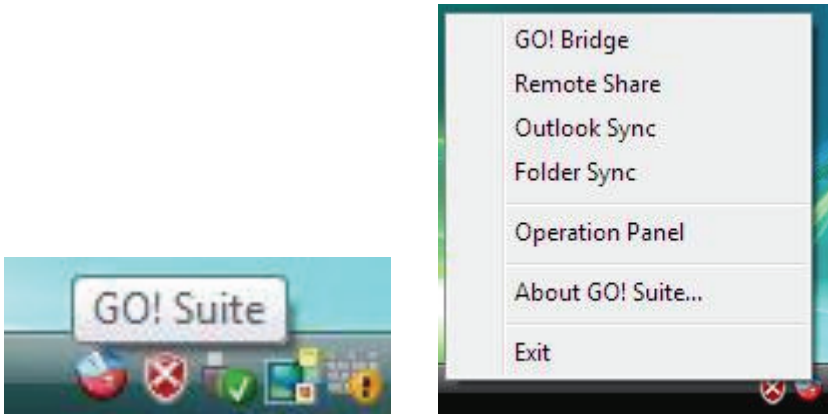
2. You may select **Open folder to view files** and directly open the source Disk as above or to use **GO! Suite** and execute the installer program.

1. Plug the USB cable to your local PC and the following Window will appear. Please click **Go! Bridge**.

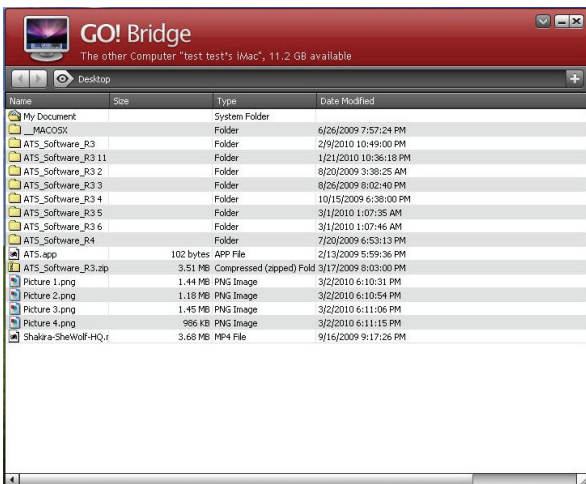

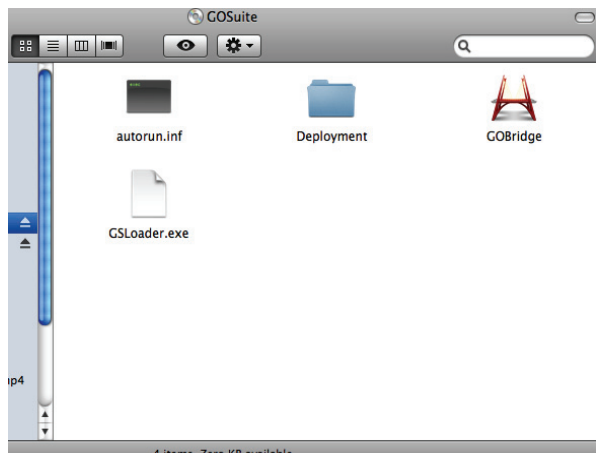
1. Plug the USB cable to your MAC and the following icon will appear on your desktop. Please click the icon.



2. You will see the **GO! Bridge** Window as following.

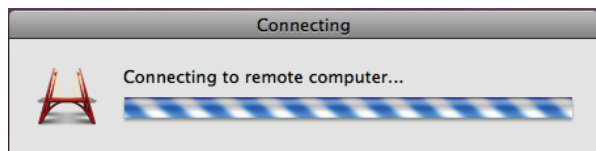

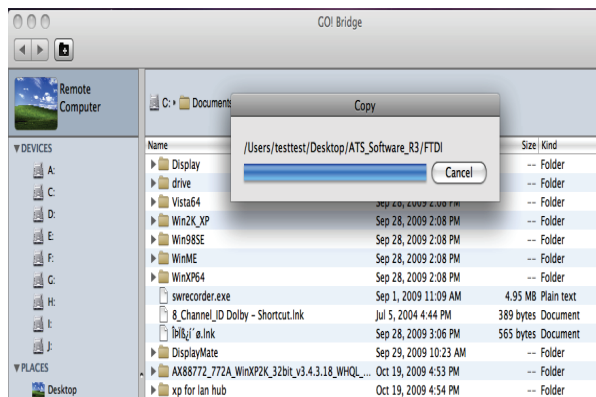
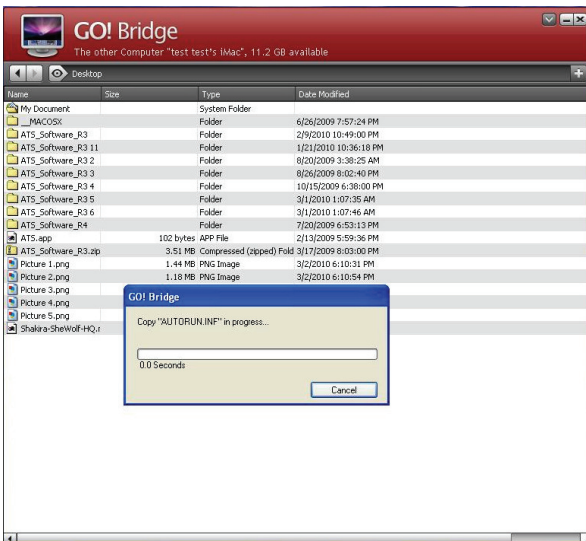
