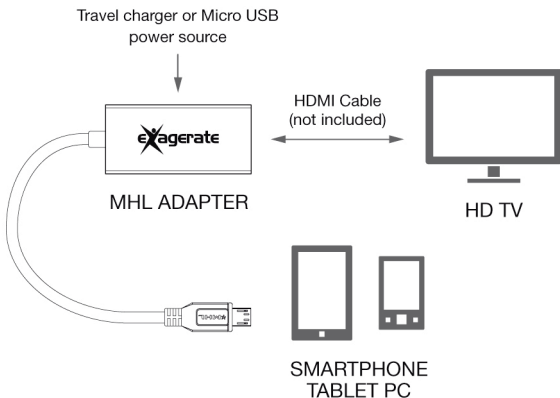
The new Exagerate MHL-HDMI cable adapter allows you to easily connect a smartphone, tablet PC or other MHL enabled device to an HDMI TV using an HDMI cable\*.

## Installation and use

---

The following picture shows the installation and use of the Exagerate MHL adapter (XMHL100).



1. With the power to the TV off, connect an HDMI cable\* from the HDMI port on the MHL adapter to the HDMI port on your TV.
2. Connect the travel charger of your mobile devices or a micro USB power cable to the charge port on the side of the adapter.
3. Plug your mobile device's travel charger or the micro USB cable into a power source.
4. Connect the MHL adapter connector to your mobile device.

5. Turn on the TV and MHL source device.
6. Configure the TV to the HDMI input being used. Refer to the TV's instructions for more information.
7. If needed, configure your MHL enabled device to output audio and/or video through the MHL connector. Refer to the source device's instruction manual for more information on enabling the MHL output.
